Scenario 1



You need a tutor to help you with your Chinese. It happened that there is a Chinese exchange student at your school. Both of you participate in some extracurricular activities besides attending classes. Talk to each other to figure out when you could meet. You plan to meet twice a week, one hour each time.

In your conversation, you should include the following:

- What classes you have and when;
- What after school activities you have and when;
- What time both of you are free;
- When and where you are going to meet.

Scenario 2

You are new to a Chinese school. After you get your class schedule, you have to find where these classrooms are. You met a Chinese student who looks willing to help. You ask him to tell you where the classrooms are, and he gives you a lot of help.

In your conversation, you should include the following:

- What classes do you have this year;
- Who the teachers are;
- Whether the classes are easy or fun;
- Where the classrooms are located;

- How you can get there.

Scenario 1

You are to promote your school to a Chinese high school league in order to find a matching sister school.

You prepared a PPT and present it in the conference.



In your presentation, you should include the following:

- Your school name
- Student number and staff number
- Principal's name and some other important faculty's name and occupation
- School facilities
- Courses offered
- Extracurricular activities offered
- Major achievements of your school
- Some other information
